WEEKLY MESSAGE FROM PASTOR FRICKE

The Strange Thing about Christianity

What does Christianity mean to you? Christian theologian J. Gresham Machen once commented that "the strange thing about Christianity was that it transformed the lives of men [simply] by telling a story." The effect of the Christian faith is that, as Machen says, "the lives of men are transformed by a piece of news."

The story begins with God's creation of all humankind, followed immediately by man's fall into sin and God's promise to save fallen humanity. To shepherds watching their flocks in the fields near Bethlehem the news that "today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you" made all the difference in the world (Luke 2:10). And it was a piece of news that forever changed the lives of the grieving whom who went to anoint Jesus' lifeless body: "He is not here; he has risen, just as he said" (Matthew 28:6).

The Christian faith is not so much about what we do for God; it is more about what's already been done for us by God. It focuses not on the lives we live for Christ, but on the life he lived for us. The birth of a little Child still transforms lives. Let the story of his birth, death, and resurrection live in your hearts throughout the year.
