
### **Nobody Understood**


Nobody really understood Jesus. The Jewish ruling council accused him of "subverting" the nation, but that was a lie. Jesus was helping people to see through the misleading teachings of their leaders. They said he opposed paying taxes to Caesar. That was also untrue. Then they accused him of claiming to be a king—and he was a king, of course. But not the kind of king who posed any threat to Rome. Their allegations were entirely false.

Nobody understood Jesus—not the Sanhedrin, or Pilate, or Herod, or the people who clamored for his death. But what about us? Do we understand him and the reason he came? Do we expect our lives to be easy simply because we follow him? Do we assume he's going to give us everything we ask for in prayer? Do we bristle under the hard times we have to go through? Do we feel we can accept his forgiveness without offering it to others?

Jesus was mocked, abused, rejected, and killed. Do you understand why? It was because of your sins ...and mine. It was because he understood how deep and grievous they are. It was because he saw the punishment those sins have earned...and he loved us deeply enough to care.
